PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is resurfacing all travel lanes on State Road (S.R.) 419 between S.R. 434 and south of U.S. 17-92 (S.R. 15/600). This will include both asphalt and concrete pavement. The purpose of this project is to extend the service life of S.R. 419. Other improvements include construction of curb and gutter, shoulders, concrete sidewalk, underground storm drain systems, signs, and signalization.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Motorists should expect intermittent daytime and nighttime single lane closures on S.R. 419 between S.R. 434 and south of U.S. 17-92 (S.R. 15/600), where the road is being resurfaced.

Pedestrian access to sidewalks will be maintained using detour signs, traffic control devices, and temporary walkways and ramps.

Please be advised that it is the property owner's responsibility to remove or relocate any privatelyowned irrigation, landscaping, decorations, and fencing within FDOT right of way before the start of construction. FDOT reserves the right to cut and cap any irrigation and remove any items that conflict with the planned work in the right of way.


