PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is resurfacing South Fiske Boulevard (State Road (S.R.) 519) from the northbound Interstate 95 (I-95) ramps in Rockledge to King Street (S.R. 520) in Cocoa. In addition to placing new pavement, 6-foot-wide buffered bicycle lanes will be added in both northbound and southbound directions on South Fiske Boulevard. The roadway will continue to have two through lanes in each direction, and existing turn lanes will be maintained.

Pedestrian improvements include Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant crosswalks and upgraded pedestrian curb ramps. Pedestrian lighting, drainage improvements, new signing and pavement markings, and other necessary roadside improvements will be constructed.

WHAT TO EXPECT


Motorists should expect a reduction in the speed limit and alternating lane closures in both northbound and southbound directions. Electronic message boards and other signage will help direct traffic through lane closures.

Uneven pavement is a common, unavoidable roadway condition with resurfacing projects as the contractor must place layers of asphalt during different phases of construction. Motorists are asked to use extra caution while driving through the work zone. Road conditions during construction are short-term and will become less apparent as the project progresses.

Additionally, the level of work activity will vary during different phases of construction, and paving operations will be intermittent.
