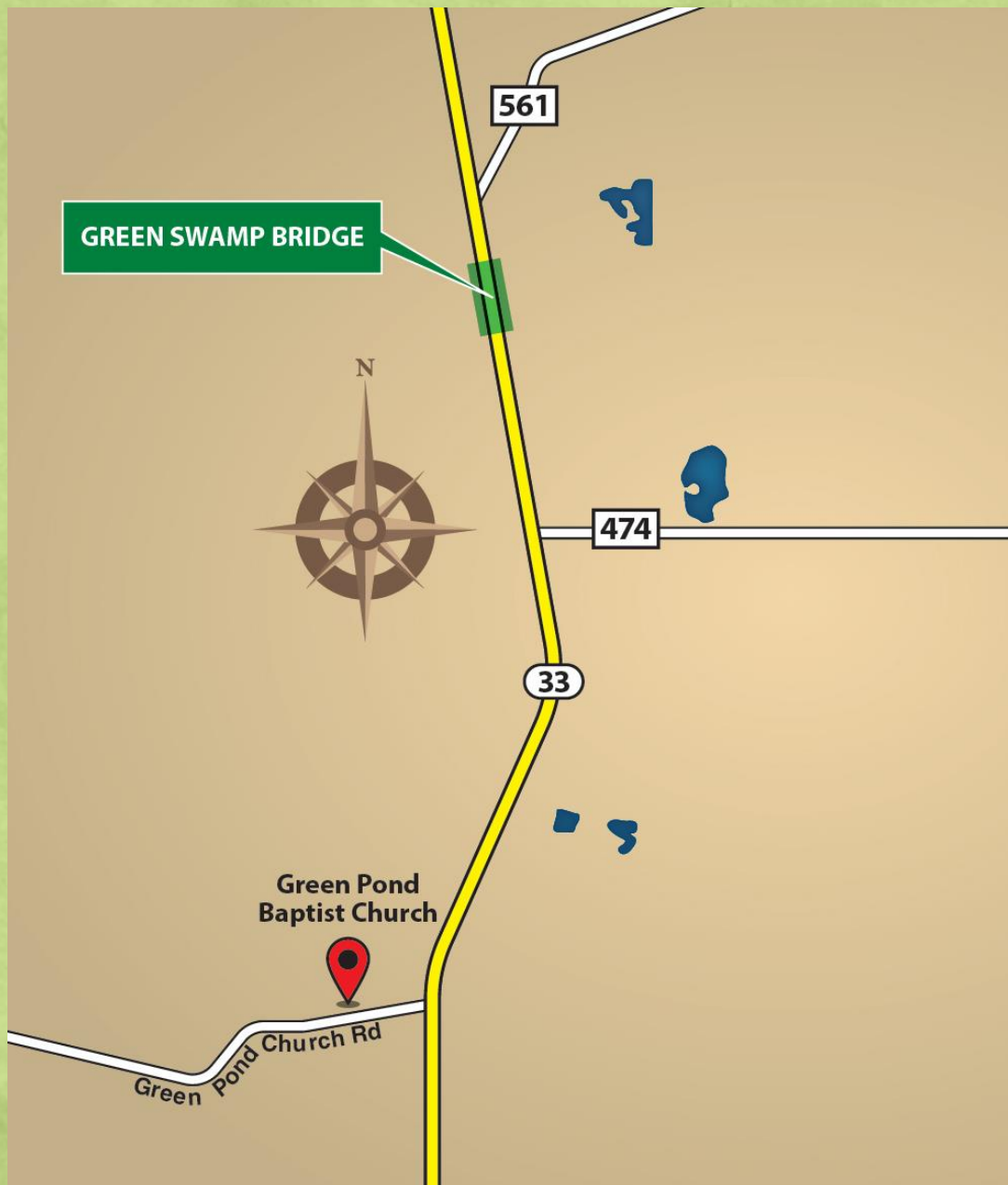

About the Project

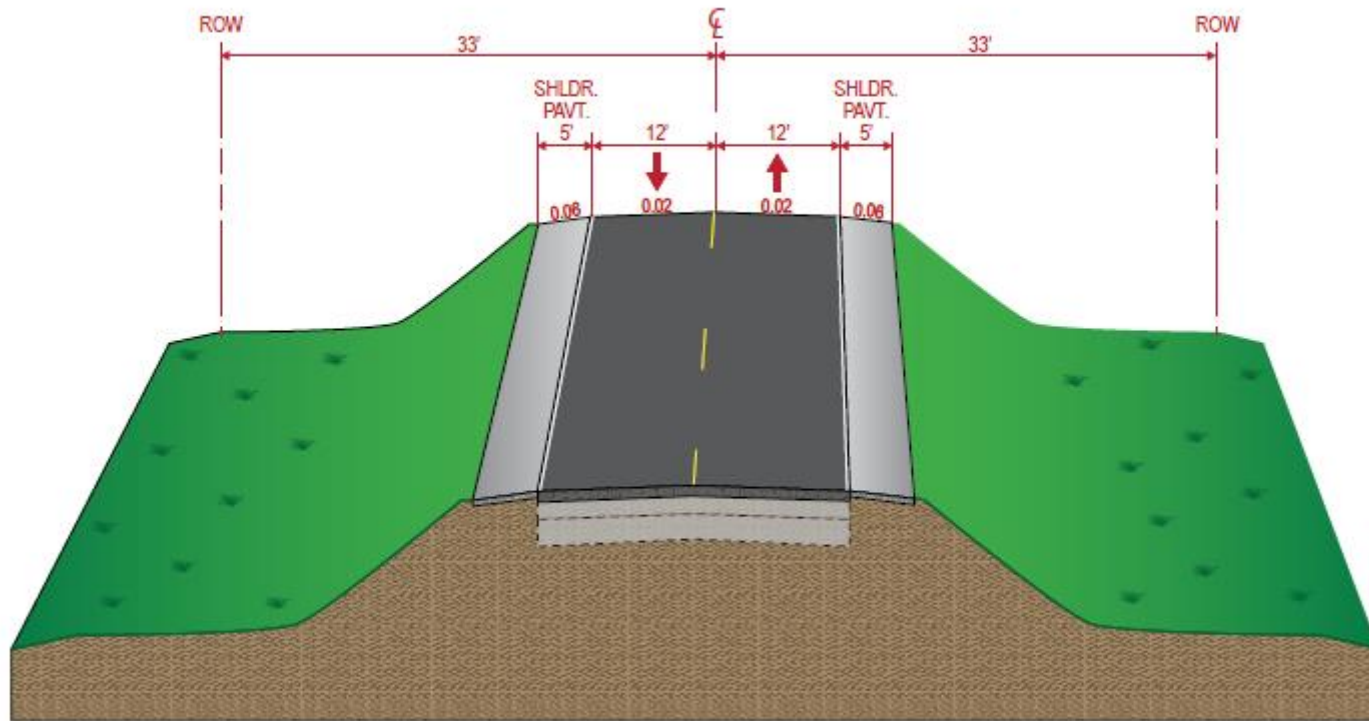
- Proposed replacement of State Road 33 bridge over Green Swamp.
- The bridge was originally built in 1956.
- 6,200 vehicles a day in 2014, with 33% of those vehicles being trucks.
- While the bridge is still safe for day to day vehicular traffic, its current design is obsolete and structurally deficient, and this bridge is scheduled to be replaced in the coming years.
- This project does not involve adding travel lanes.



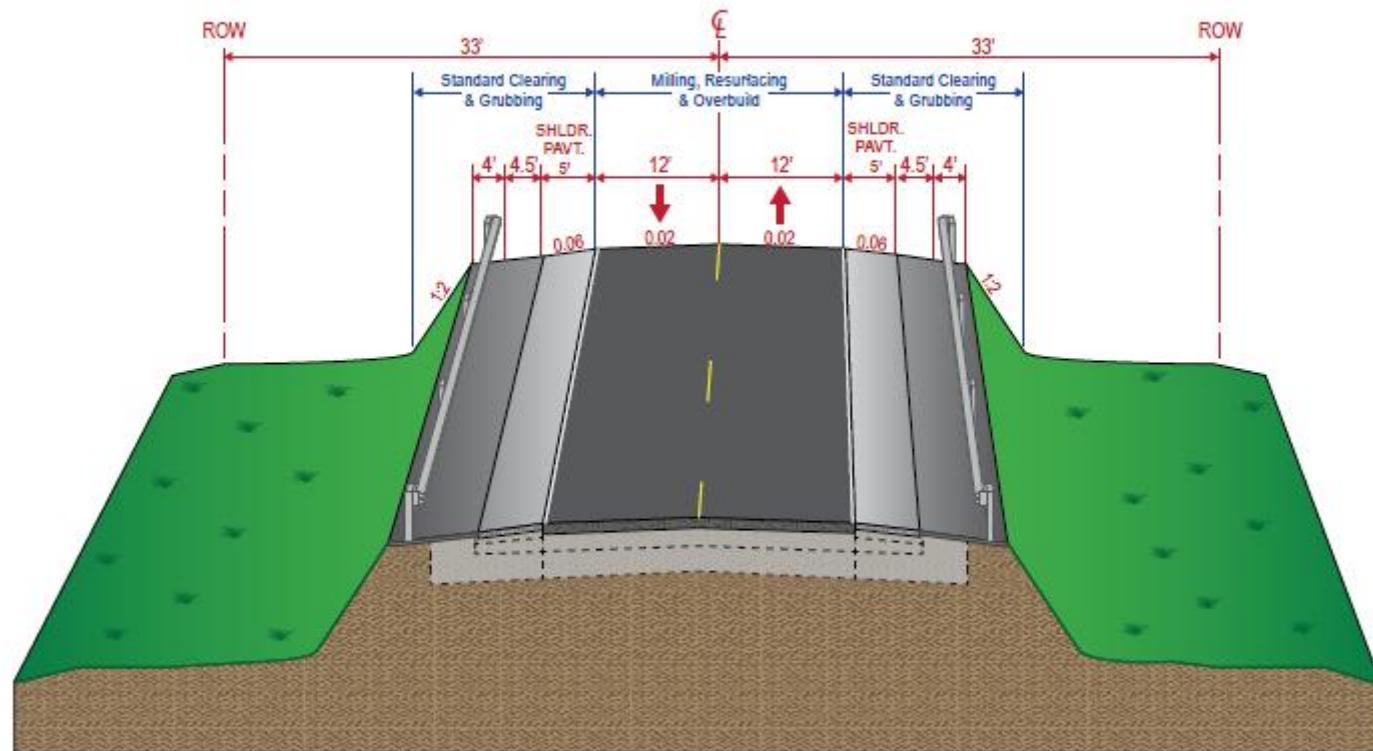
Project Description

- The project will start 500 feet on either side of the bridge.
- The approaches will match the existing roadway with one 12-foot travel lane, a 5-foot paved shoulder and 5-foot unpaved shoulder in each direction.
- The typical bridge section is expected to have a 12-foot travel lane and 10-foot paved shoulder in each direction.
- The FDOT may require additional right of way to complete the project.

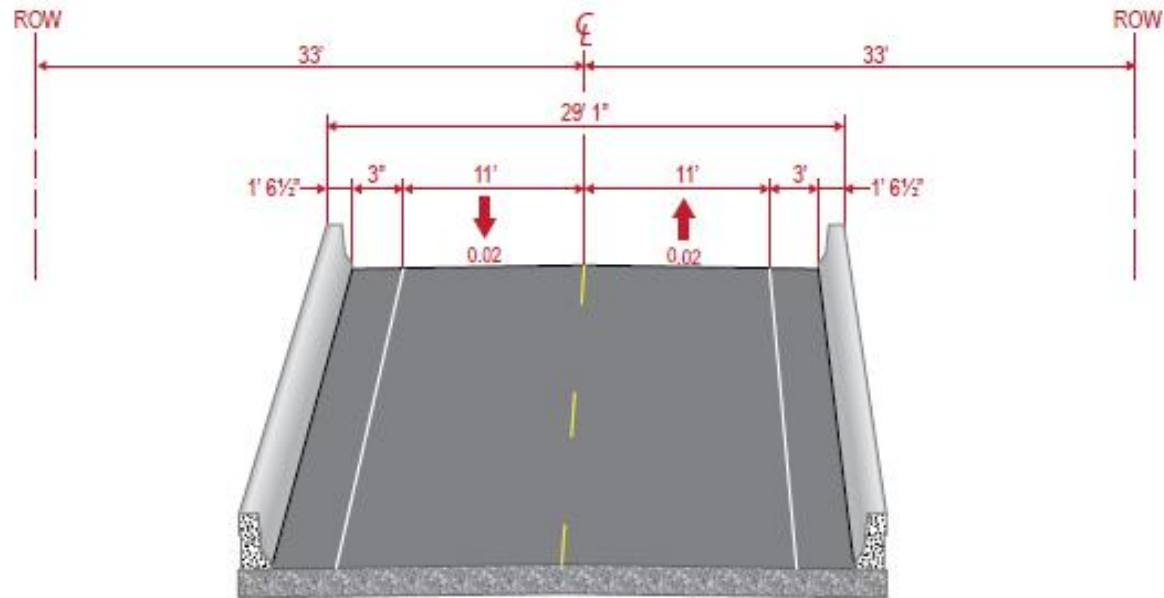
Existing Roadway



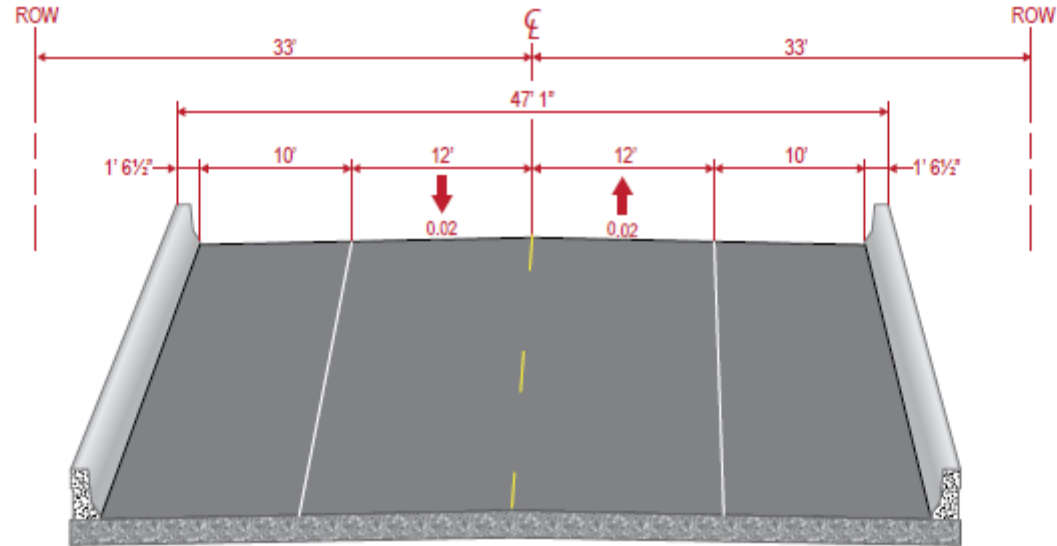
Proposed Roadway



Existing Bridge



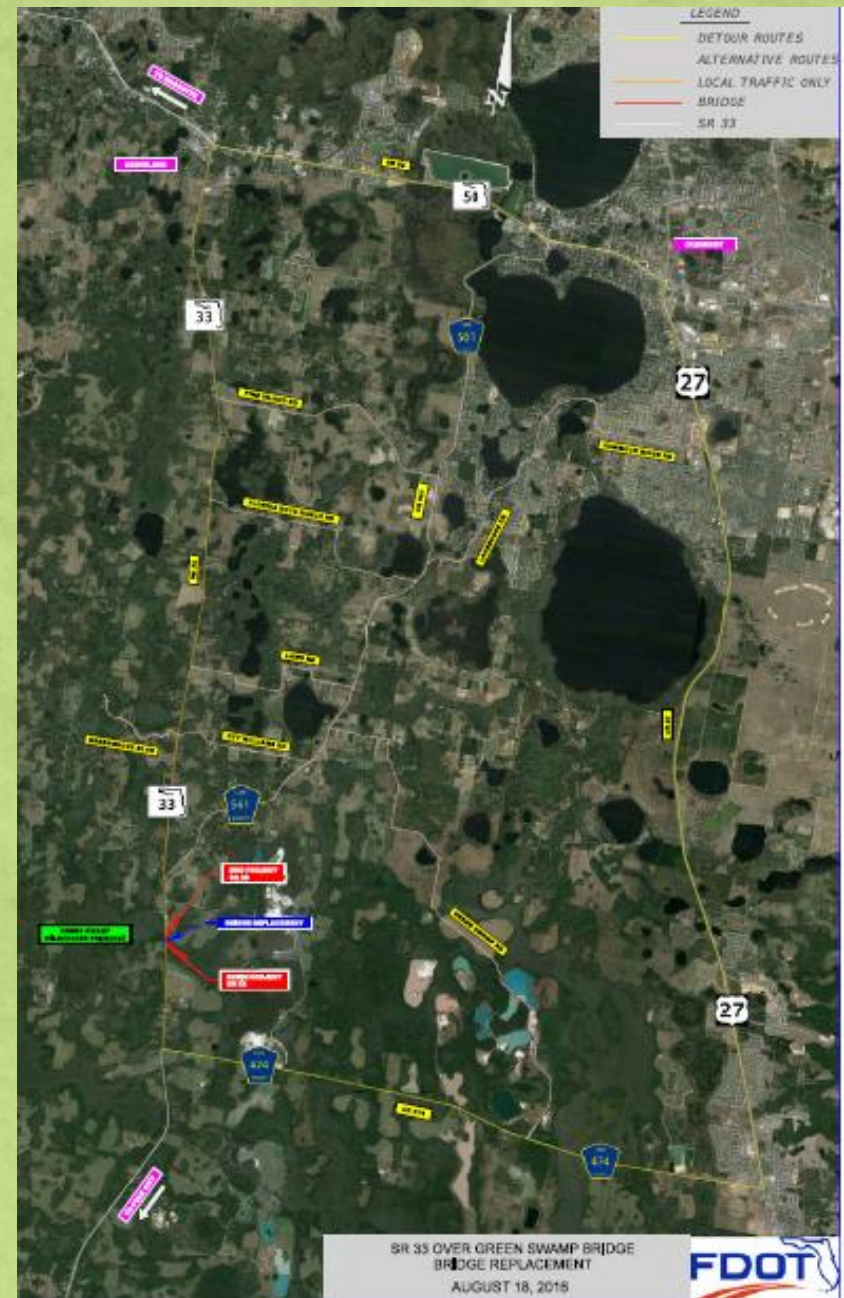
Proposed Bridge





Proposed Detour Plan

- The proposed detour is approximately 17 miles long.
- The proposed detour will decrease construction time.



Protecting Green Swamp



- Green Swamp is a critical recharge area for the Floridan aquifer, as well as the source of the Hillsborough, Withlacoochee, Ocklawaha, and Peace rivers, located within the project corridor.
- The design and construction of this project will protect the swamp by incorporating best management practices for stormwater runoff protection.
- Additionally, the project will go through a strict environmental permitting process prior to construction.



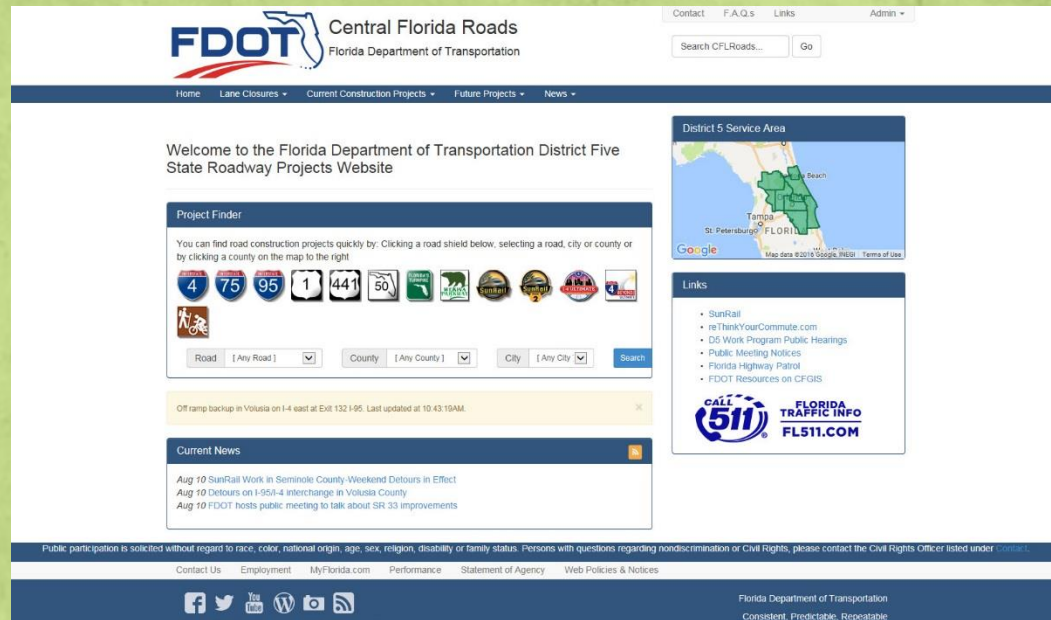
Project Schedule

- This project is currently in design.
- The Design Phase is expected to be completed in 2016.
- Estimated construction cost is approximately \$3 million.
- This project is currently funded for letting in January 2019.
- Construction is expected to start by mid-year 2019 and be completed in early 2020.
- Date could change depending on the completed design.
