The Florida Department of Transportation is holding a public hearing regarding a resurfacing project along S.R. 19 from C.R. 452 to Golden Gem Drive in Lake County. The hearing will begin as an open house at 5:30 p.m. A formal presentation will begin at 6 p.m., followed by a public comment period. A court reporter will prepare a verbatim transcript of the proceedings. In the event the public hearing cannot be held on Sept. 10, due to severe weather or other unforeseen conditions, it will be held on the alternate date of Tuesday Oct. 1, 2019, at the same time and place.

**PROPOSED ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS**

The purpose of the project is to resurface the roadway in the southbound direction only. Improvements also include pedestrian, bicycle, and safety items along both sides of the road. The addition of sidewalk and access management improvements (median changes) are included throughout the project limits. Intersection lighting is proposed at C.R. 452 and C.R. 44. Additionally, roadway lighting is proposed from south of C.R. 452 to Pine Meadows Golf Course.
