### **U.S. 301/U.S. 441 Median Modifications and Resurfacing from NW 20<sup>th</sup> St. to the U.S. 301/U.S. 441 Interchange, Marion County**

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will hold a public hearing regarding project plans on U.S. 301/U.S. 441 on Wednesday, January 27, 2021, at 5:30 p.m. The purpose of this project is to improve safety with median modifications and resurfacing the roadway. The Department is offering multiple ways to participate in the hearing. All participants will participate in the same live hearing.
