ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS

Oakridge Boulevard from the east side of the Halifax River to S.R.A1A

Volusia County

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is beginning work on safety improvements on Oakridge Boulevard (State Road (S.R.) 430) from the east side of the Halifax River to S.R. A1A. The work will reduce the number of travel lanes from three to two. In addition, the roadway will be resurfaced, which will extend the life of the pavement.

These changes will allow for a 7-foot-wide buffered bicycle lane, as well as a bicycle bail-out at Grandview Avenue. A bicycle bail-out provides a place where bicycles can leave the bike lane to ride on the sidewalk. In addition, these changes to the travel lanes will provide a dedicated left turn onto Peninsula Drive. Landscaping improvements are also included in the project.

WHAT TO EXPECT

This project will require single and double lane closures on Oakridge Boulevard from just east of the Halifax River to S.R. A1A. Closures are expected during daytime and nighttime hours.

During resurfacing work, motorists may encounter uneven pavement, which occurs as crews place new layers of asphalt during various construction phases. Motorists are asked to use extra caution while driving through the work zone. Road conditions during construction are short-term and will become less apparent as the project progresses.

Additionally, the level of work activity will vary during different phases of construction, and paving operations will be intermittent. The contractor will maintain pedestrian access to sidewalks during construction using signed detours, and/or temporary walkways and ramps, when appropriate.

Please be advised it is the property owner's responsibility to remove or relocate any privately owned irrigation, landscaping, decorations, and/or fencing within FDOT right of way before the start of construction. FDOT reserves the right to cut and cap any irrigation and remove any items that conflict with the planned work in the right of way.
