


S.R. 436 ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS

Northlake Boulevard/Cranes Roost Boulevard to Boston Avenue Altamonte Springs, Florida | Seminole County

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The City of Altamonte Springs, in conjunction with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), has a roadway improvement project underway along State Road (S.R.) 436 (E. Altamonte Drive) between Northlake Boulevard/Cranes Roost Boulevard and Boston Avenue. The purpose of this project is to extend the service life of the pavement and improve bicycle/pedestrian amenities along the corridor. The posted speed is 40 MPH.

The roadway typical section will be modified to include curb and gutter with 11-foot wide travel lanes with no shoulder. Improvements include milling and resurfacing, new concrete curb and gutter, new drainage system, multi-use trail, concrete bikeway, upgraded street lighting and street trees. The City of Altamonte Springs is preparing the design plans and FDOT will be constructing the project.
