



Orange Avenue (S.R. 527) from Sand Lake Road (S.R. 482) to Prince Street

Project Description

The intent of this project is to rehabilitate the asphalt pavement to extend the longevity of Orange Avenue (State Road (S.R.) 527) from Sand Lake Road (S.R. 482) to Prince Street in the community of Pine Castle. Orange Avenue provides two travel lanes in each direction and a center turn lane through a portion of the project within the project limits. The roadway configuration will not change with the proposed improvements.

Proposed improvements include milling and resurfacing travel lanes, reconstructing the concrete island at Sand Lake Road, and a variety of pedestrian improvements such as realigning crosswalks, closing sidewalk gaps, reconstructing curb ramps, and upgrading pedestrian signals. Also included in the project are related drainage, signage, and pavement marking improvements.
