INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS

State Road (S.R.) 436 and Howell Branch Road

Seminole County

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will be making various improvements to the intersection of State Road (S.R.) 436 (Semoran Boulevard) and Howell Branch Road in Casselberry. The project will construct an additional left turn lane on eastbound Howell Branch Road to northbound Semoran Boulevard, which will increase capacity for motorists turning left and help prevent cars from lining up in the through lanes. The traffic signals will also be upgraded from a system of cables and poles to a new mast arm system where signal heads are mounted on a rigid arm that extends over the roadway.

In addition, work will include various safety upgrades, such as pedestrian signal replacements, sidewalk improvements and intersection lighting. These upgrades are being done to meet Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements.

WHAT TO EXPECT

There will be single-lane closures during nighttime hours (10:30 p.m. through 6 a.m.) at the S.R. 436 and Howell Branch Road intersection. The contractor will maintain access to sidewalks, businesses and residences during construction. The construction schedule may change due to weather or other unexpected conditions.
