PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is making modifications to the median along West Silver Springs Boulevard (State Road (S.R.) 40), from east of Southwest 27th Avenue to Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard in Ocala. These changes are being made to improve safety for drivers along this corridor.

The work will involve converting full median openings to directional openings, permanently closing three existing full median openings, and extending some of the turn lanes. Directional medians control the direction that vehicles may turn, reducing opportunities for vehicles to come in conflict.

WHAT TO EXPECT

During construction, motorists should expect lane closures between 8 p.m. and 6 a.m. However, occasional daytime lane closures could occur. Electronic message boards and other signage will be used to direct traffic through the work zone.
