

## YOU ARE INVITED TO A PUBLIC HEARING

The Florida Department of Transportation is holding a public hearing regarding an access management design project along S.R. 40, also known as West Silver Springs Boulevard. The hearing will begin as an open house at 5:30 p.m. A formal presentation will begin at 6 p.m., followed by a public comment period. A court reporter will prepare a verbatim transcript of the proceedings. In the event the public hearing cannot be held on Oct. 8, due to severe weather or other unforeseen conditions, it will be held on the alternate date of Thursday, Oct. 22, 2019, at the same time and place.

## PROPOSED ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS

The purpose of the project is to provide access management improvements along West Silver Springs Boulevard. Due to the high number of collisions that occur in this area, median opening modifications are being proposed to improve safety, reduce the number of incidents and improve traffic operations. The project will also include landscaping removal or replanting during construction in some areas. All work will take place within existing right of way.
