

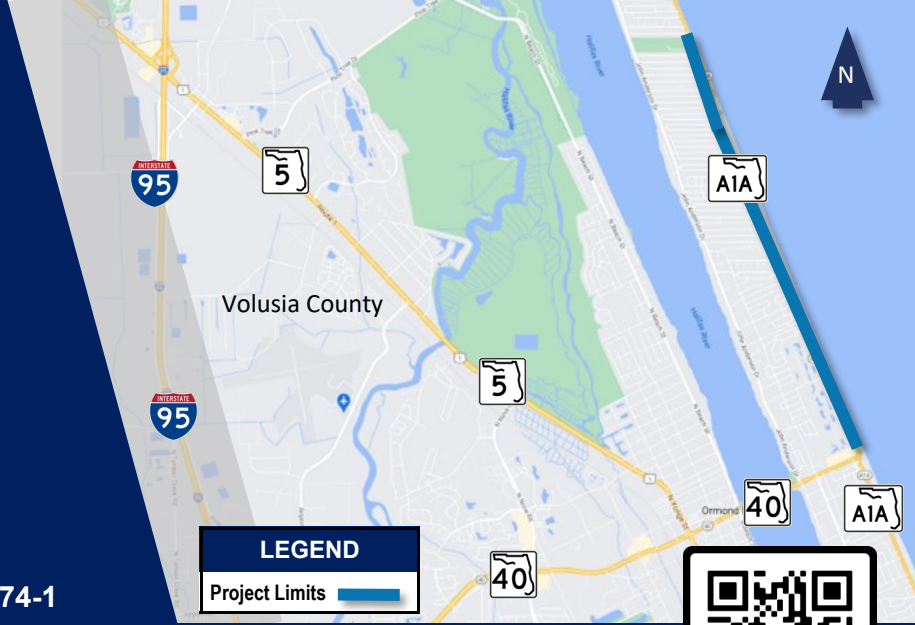


S.R. A1A Improvements

from North of Granada Boulevard (S.R. 40) to Sandra Drive

Volusia County

Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is planning improvements along State Road (S.R.) A1A from north of Granada Boulevard (S.R. 40) to Sandra Drive in Ormond Beach. The goal of the project is to repave this portion of S.R. A1A and to enhance safety and operations for all users.

The design for the project incorporates elements proposed to the community through the North Ormond Beach Area Coalition planning effort. To help encourage safer driving speeds, the project proposes to introduce subtle alignment shifts and add curb and gutter along the corridor. Improvements also include the addition of left turn lanes at the intersection of Neptune Avenue for enhanced traffic operations.

Proposed pedestrian safety enhancements include new sidewalk where possible and a shared-use path on the west side of the road. Existing pedestrian curb ramps will be upgraded to current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards. Raised midblock crossings with pedestrian activated signals are also planned. Traffic signal, lighting upgrades and drainage improvements will also be included.
