## PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will improve safety and traffic operations on State Road (S.R.) 520. FDOT aims to extend the service life of the roadway by resurfacing along S.R. 520 from west of Yates Road to the Brevard County Line in Orange County. This 10-mile resurfacing and rehabilitation project will include quardrail replacements, updating pavement markings, and widening improvements along the roadway. This project will also improve roadway conditions for motorists, help enhance drivability in the area, and ensure roadway longevity.

## WHAT TO EXPECT

Motorists should expect single daytime and nighttime lane closures throughout construction. Electronic message boards and other signage will be used to alert motorists of traffic changes. Uneven pavement is a common, unavoidable roadway condition with projects that require resurfacing as the contractor must place different layers of asphalt during various phases of construction. Road conditions during construction will become less apparent as the project progresses. Motorists are asked to exercise caution and reduce their speed while driving through the work zone.
