




Project Purpose - Resurface

Pedestrian Enhancements

- Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) improvements
- Pedestrian crosswalks to be added at three intersections
 - North Amelia Avenue
 - North Garfield Avenue
 - Jacobs Road/Detrick Avenue
- Upgraded traffic and pedestrian signal features


- Upgrade transportation system communications





Route 60 – East/West Connector










FDOT You can Participate - Online
