The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will hold a public meeting regarding project plans on S.R. A1A from Milsap Road to Granada Boulevard (S.R. 40) in Ormond Beach on Wednesday, January 12, at 5:30 p.m. The purpose of this project is to improve traffic operations and enhance pedestrian safety. Following a public hearing in December 2020, FDOT revised the plans to address community concerns. This public meeting is to present updated information and receive community feedback. FDOT is offering multiple ways to participate in the same live meeting.
