SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS

S.R. A1A from Milsap Road to Granada Boulevard (S.R. 40)

Volusia County

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is implementing pedestrian safety improvements by installing eight new mid-block crosswalks along State Road (S.R.) A1A from just south of Milsap Road to just north of Granada Boulevard (S.R. 40) in Ormond Beach, Volusia County. Improvements will also include resurfacing of the existing pavement, curb and gutter, concrete sidewalk upgrades, traffic separator installation, and lighting enhancements.

Seven of the new crosswalks will be equipped with Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons (RRFBs) and signage to enhance pedestrian safety. Each RRFB will include flashing yellow LED lights to increase drivers' awareness of pedestrians crossing S.R. A1A at the following locations:

- Milsap Road
- Benjamin Drive
- River Beach Drive
- Arlington Way
- Ormond Parkway
- Osceola Avenue
- Bosarvey Drive

Additionally, a new crosswalk will be installed at Rockefeller Drive and equipped with a Pedestrian Hybrid Beacon (PHB). A PHB is an overhead traffic device that remains dark until a pedestrian activates the beacon, signaling for drivers to stop and for pedestrians to cross.

Audible pedestrian signals and detectible warning pads will also be installed at each new mid-block crossing to provide accessibility for the visually impaired.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Motorists should expect intermittent nighttime lane closures on S.R. A1A between the hours of 7 p.m. and 7 a.m. during construction. Electronic message boards and other signage will be used to direct traffic around closures. Intermittent sidewalk detours will be utilized to accommodate pedestrian traffic around the work area. Access to side streets, residences, and businesses will be maintained throughout the duration of the project.

The level of work activity will vary during different phases of construction, and the schedule may change due to weather or other unforeseen circumstances.
