## U.S. 441 Roadway Improvements

This project is located in Mount Dora, Lake County along **U.S. 441 from east of State Road (S.R.) 44 to south of Lincoln Avenue**. The purpose of this project is to extend the life of the existing roadway by **repaving** this segment of U.S. 441 and **improving safety** along the corridor. Safety improvements include converting the full median opening at Pine Avenue to a directional median opening.
