PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will resurface State Road (S.R.) 40 from east of Rodeo Road to east of Bayberry Drive in Ormond Beach, Volusia County, to create a safer and smoother ride for the traveling public. Work also includes new roadway markings, signage, drainage improvements, and Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS) components to improve safety, mobility, and efficiency for all road users.

Additional safety improvements include traffic signal upgrades, along with sidewalk and pedestrian curb ramp reconstruction to meet Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Motorists should expect intermittent single lane closures on eastbound and westbound S.R. 40 during construction. Electronic message boards and other signage will be used to alert motorists of closures.

Uneven pavement is a common, unavoidable roadway condition with projects that require resurfacing, as the contractor must place different layers of asphalt during various phases of construction. Motorists are asked to exercise caution and reduce their speed while driving through the work zone. The contractor will maintain pedestrian access to sidewalks during construction using signed detours, traffic control devices, and/or temporary walkways and ramps, when appropriate.
