PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will improve safety and traffic operations on State Road (S.R.) 520 (W. King Street). FDOT aims to extend the service life of the roadway by resurfacing S.R. 520 from the east side of the St. Johns River bridge to just west of S.R. 524 in Brevard County. Additional improvements will include guardrail replacements, updated pavement markings and various work along the roadway shoulder. This resurfacing and rehabilitation project will improve roadway conditions for motorists, help enhance drivability in the area, and ensure roadway longevity.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Motorists should expect lane closures and detours on weekdays and weekends. Electronic message boards and other signage will be used to direct traffic. Uneven pavement is a common roadway condition with resurfacing projects as the contractor must put down different layers of asphalt during various phases of construction. Such road conditions during construction are short-term and will become less apparent as the project progresses. Motorists are asked to use extra caution while driving through the work zone. Traffic fines are doubled when construction workers are onsite. Additionally, the level of work activity will vary during different phases of construction and paving operations will be intermittent.


