OPEN HOUSE SCHEDULED

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) invites you to attend an open house about plans to install a new traffic signal at the intersection of Eau Gallie Boulevard (State Road 518) and Turtle Mound Road in Melbourne. The open house will be held on **Tuesday, January 7, 2020, from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. at Discover Life Church located at 3550 W. Eau Gallie Boulevard, Melbourne, FL 32934.** You may come any time during those hours to review project displays and to hold one-on-one conversations with the FDOT project team. There will be no presentation.

The purpose of this project is to signalize the intersection of Eau Gallie Boulevard and Turtle Mound Road. This project also includes the extension of the right and left turn lanes onto Turtle Mound Road, along with the addition of high visibility crosswalk markings, pedestrian signals and lighting. Additional right of way will be needed for this project. Construction is expected to begin by summer 2022 at an estimated cost of \$592,000.
