# **ROADWAY RESURFACING**

S.R. 518/Eau Gallie Boulevard at Turtle Mound Road Intersection

## **Brevard County**

### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will be improving safety and traffic operations on State Road (S.R.) 518/ Eau Gallie Boulevard at the Turtle Mound Intersection. FDOT aims to extend the service life of the roadway by resurfacing the intersection on S.R. 518/ Eau Gallie Boulevard in Brevard County. This resurfacing and rehabilitation project will include updating drainage, pedestrian curbs, and pavement markings along the roadway. This project will improve roadway conditions for motorists, help enhance drivability in the area, and ensure roadway longevity.

#### WHAT TO EXPECT

Motorists should expect lane closures throughout construction. Electronic message boards and other signage will be used to alert motorists of traffic changes. Uneven pavement is a common, unavoidable roadway condition with projects that require resurfacing, as the contractor must place different layers of asphalt during various phases of construction. Road conditions during construction will become less apparent as the project progresses. Motorists are asked to exercise caution and reduce their speed while driving through the work zone.


