U.S. 17-92 (S. Orange Blossom Trail/John Young Parkway) Improvements, Osceola County

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will hold a public hearing regarding two project plans on U.S. 17-92 on Thursday, May 13, at 5:30 p.m. The first project will relieve congestion and improve operations at the intersection of U.S. 17-92 and Pleasant Hill Road by constructing a new road – realigning The Oaks Boulevard to the west – and the second project will resurface U.S. 17-92 (S. Orange Blossom Trail/John Young Parkway) from east of Ham Road to south of Portage Street and enhance pedestrian safety along the corridor. FDOT is offering multiple ways to participate in the same live hearing.

Virtual: Join from a computer, tablet, or mobile device for free and listen to the live presentation over the internet. Advance registration at https://fdot.cc/jyp-vph is required; participants will receive an email with information about joining the hearing online. Please note, Internet Explorer cannot be used to register or attend this webinar.

All safety and sanitation guidelines and local ordinances must be followed. Persons who are not feeling well should not attend the in-person hearing.

The hearing will open at 5:30 p.m., and the presentation will begin promptly at 6 p.m. If joining online, please allow adequate log-in time prior to the presentation.
