

U.S. 441 **Intersection Improvements** at Eudora Road (C.R. 44C)

Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) proposes to enhance pedestrian and motorist safety, as well as traffic efficiency at the intersection of U.S. 441 and Eudora Road (County Road (C.R.) 44C).

Proposed improvements on Eudora Road, south of the U.S. 441 intersection, aim to reduce vehicle conflict points by installing vertical posts to separate travel lanes. Mount Dora First National Bank and 7-Eleven driveways will continue to allow right turns onto Eudora Road; however, left turns onto Eudora Road will be limited. Motorists will still be able to turn left from the southern driveway to Mount Dora First National Bank. Motorists leaving 7-Eleven who wish to travel northbound (NB), eastbound (EB), or westbound (WB) can still utilize driveways along U.S. 441.

Additional planned improvements include reconstruction of the traffic signal, reconstructing the curbs to shorten the crossing distance for pedestrians and upgrading the crosswalks. Sidewalk improvements and reconstructing the curb ramps to comply with current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards are also planned. The intersection will also be resurfaced and upgraded signs and pavement markings will be installed.
