The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will hold a public meeting regarding project plans on South Williams Street (U.S. 41) from Brittan Alexander Bridge to River Drive on September 7, at 5:30 p.m. The purpose of this project is to improve safety and mobility on the project corridor by upgrading the existing pedestrian crossing and adding a bi-directional median opening near Dunnellon City Hall.
