S.R. A1A Safety Improvements, Flagler County

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will hold a public hearing regarding project plans on State Road (S.R.) A1A from north of Ocean Marina Drive to south of Westmayer Place on Thursday, July 15, at 5:30 p.m. The purpose of this project is to enhance vehicular and pedestrian safety in the Town of Beverly Beach. Project plans include repaving S.R. A1A within the project limits as well as operational improvements to enhance mobility along the corridor. Improvements for pedestrian visibility and connectivity are also being proposed. FDOT is offering multiple ways to participate in the same live hearing.

The hearing will open at 5:30 p.m., and the presentation will begin promptly at 5:45 p.m. If joining online, please allow adequate log-in time prior to the presentation.
