




Colonial Drive (S.R. 50) Safety Improvements from Pine Hills Road to Tampa Avenue

Important Project Update

This Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) project is intended to enhance safety and operations along Colonial Drive (State Road (S.R.) 50) between Pine Hills Road and Tampa Avenue. As FDOT works to achieve its goal of zero fatalities on Florida’s state highways, it is sharpening its focus on using every tool available to enhance safety for drivers, pedestrians, and bicyclists within every project.

As a result, the Department is revisiting the planned improvements for this segment of West Colonial Drive. The additional review will likely change the design concept originally developed, which focused on improving safety by making changes to the existing median along the corridor.

FDOT is now seeking your feedback about conditions such as driver speed in the area, where pedestrians frequently cross West Colonial Boulevard and how easily they can cross in that area, and how often and where bicyclists travel the corridor. This input will assist with the Department’s evaluation. Once the additional analysis has been completed, another public meeting will be planned to present an updated design plan and receive comments.
