TRAFFIC SIGNAL IMPROVEMENTS

Intersection of S.R. 441 (Orange Blossom Trail) and S.R. 50 (Colonial Drive)

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will install mast arms for traffic signal improvements at the intersection of U.S. 441 (Orange Blossom Trail) and State Road 50 (Colonial Drive). Other features of this project include milling and resurfacing the roadway, improving the sidewalk, curbs, and signs. The project will also include new pedestrian lights to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements.

WHAT TO EXPECT

During construction, motorists should expect daytime and nighttime lane closures and detours on weekdays and weekends. Electronic message boards and other signage will be used to direct traffic through the work zone. Road conditions during construction will become less apparent as the project progresses. Motorists are asked to exercise caution and reduce their speed while driving through the work zone. Due to construction, there might be some noise around the area.

The contractor will maintain pedestrian access to sidewalks during construction using signed detours, traffic control devices, and/or temporary walkways and ramps, when appropriate. The construction schedule may change due to weather, special events, and other unexpected conditions.
