




Intersection Safety Improvements

Kirkman Road (S.R. 435) at Windhover Drive

Orange County

Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is proposing safety improvements to the intersection of Kirkman Road (State Road (S.R.) 435) and Windhover Drive. The project proposes to eliminate the directional median opening and construct a new traffic signal as recommended in a study conducted in 2019.

Project plans also include adding new crosswalks and reconstructing sidewalk curb ramps to enhance pedestrian safety and comply with current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards.

Operations will be improved by extending the dual left turn lanes on southbound Kirkman Road approaching Vineland Road and providing a new designated left turn lane, along with a through/right turn lane, on eastbound and westbound Windhover Drive.

The project also will provide a new bicycle lane on eastbound Windhover Drive, west of Kirkman Road, by reconstructing the traffic separator. The new bicycle lane will connect to the existing bicycle lane east of Kirkman Road.
