## **PROJECT FACTS**

This project is to mill and resurface the roadway.

Americans with Disability Act (ADA) upgrades will be provided at the 13 signalized intersections: lighting, cross walks, improvements at bus bays and handrail upgrades.

Bike lane keyholes will be provided at locations that currently do not have them.

Restriping and pavement widening in some locations and minor drainage improvements.

A shared use path will also be included along a portion of the project corridor.



No additional right of way will be needed. This project is funded for construction in 2019.
