



Signal Installation State Road (S.R.) 434 at Tarry Town Trail/Roxboro Road

Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation will be installing new traffic signals at the intersection of S.R. 434 and Tarry Town Trail/Roxboro Road. The project involves construction of single mast arms for the signals, as well as extending the left turn lanes at the intersection to meet current design standards.

The new signals and turn lane extensions are being constructed to increase safety at the intersection. Construction will begin with building the bases for the mast arms in early January. The signals are expected to be installed by spring 2018.

Information for Motorists and Pedestrians

The work will require periodic daytime and nighttime single lane closures. Motorists are asked to please use caution in the area and be alert for changing traffic patterns. Construction may also require temporary sidewalk closures and changes to pedestrian routes. Pedestrians will be safely directed around the work.
