WHAT:

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is holding an open house concerning the upcoming Design-Build project to widen Interstate 75 (I-75) in Sumter County.

Lake Panasoffkee Recreation Park, East Meeting Room, 1589 CR 459, Lake Panasoffkee, FL 33538

Project Details:

This Design-Build project will widen 13 miles of I-75 in Sumter County. The project limits are from the Hernando County line to just south of County Road (CR) 470 in Lake Panasoffkee. Other aspects of the project include a complete reconstruction of the State Road 48 (exit 314) interchange, new ramps at the CR 476B/CR673 exit (#309), upgrades to the Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS), pond construction, guardrail, signing and pavement markings, signalization and other miscellaneous structures.

Project Start: Fall 2014

Construction Cost: \$76.9 million

Estimated Project End: Winter 2016
