INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS

S.R. 15 (Conway Road) at S.R. 552 (Curry Ford Road)

PROJECT DESCRIPTION


The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will reconstruct the traffic signals at the intersection of Conway Road (State Road 15) and Curry Ford Road (State Road 552) in Orlando. The signals will be upgraded from a system of cables and poles to a new mast arm system where traffic signal heads are mounted on a rigid arm that extends over the roadway. The mast arms will allow additional signal heads for the eastbound and westbound left turn movements on Curry Ford Road.

Additional work includes curb and gutter construction, drainage improvements, new sidewalks, roadway resurfacing, curb ramp reconstruction to meet Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements, and new signing and pavement markings.

WHAT TO EXPECT

During construction, motorists should expect lane closures between 8 p.m. and 7 a.m. Electronic message boards and other signage will be used to direct traffic through the work zone.

The level of work activity will vary during different phases of construction. Please note the construction schedule may change due to weather or other unexpected conditions.
