COAST-TO-COAST TRAIL & RESURFACING

from Indian River Avenue to West of Max Brewer Bridge-Titusville Gap

Brevard County

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This project will improve roadway conditions from Indian River Avenue to west of the Max Brewer Bridge and construct a portion of the Florida Coast-to-Coast Trail on Garden Street in Titusville.

Roadway paving, curb and gutter construction, pavement markings and improved drainage are included in the scope of this project. In addition, a crosswalk equipped with safety features will be installed to help trail users cross Garden Street.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Garden Street eastbound and westbound single lane closures can be expected during daytime and nighttime hours. Electronic message boards and other signage will be in place to help direct drivers through the work zone.

Work will vary during different phases of construction, and paving operations will be intermittent.

FLORIDA COAST-TO-COAST TRAIL

The Florida Coast-to-Coast Trail is a continuously paved, multi-use trail system that when complete will connect Florida's west and east coasts. This project will complete the gap between two existing portions of the trail between Indian River Avenue at Garden Street and the recently constructed trail that begins at the eastern end of the Max Brewer Bridge extends to the entrance of the Merritt Island National Wildlife Refuge.
