



State Road 472 Resurfacing

Volusia County

Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will mill and resurface about 2.6 miles of State Road (S.R.) 472 from U.S. 17/92 (South Woodland Boulevard) in Orange City to west of the Interstate 4 interchange in DeLand. The project also includes extending the turn lanes from S.R. 472 to the Martin Luther King Jr. Beltway, and widening S.R. 472 to add a left-turn lane from eastbound S.R. 472 to northbound Minnesota Avenue. Other improvements include drainage, curbing, pavement markings, signage, and signal detection.

What to Expect During Construction

This work will require nighttime lane closures on S.R. 472. Eastbound lane closures may occur from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., while westbound lane closures are permitted from 8 p.m. to 6:30 a.m. Drivers can also expect nighttime lane closures with flagging operations on Minnesota Avenue at the S.R. 472 intersection. Electronic message boards and other signage will be used to alert motorists of closures and detours.
