PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will be resurfacing West Colonial Drive (State Road (S.R.) 50) from Tampa Avenue/Country Lane to North Orange Blossom Trail (U.S. 441/U.S. 17-92) in Orlando.

Additional improvements include drainage upgrades, curb and gutter work, sidewalk removal and reconstruction, signing and pavement markings, and traffic signal work.

WHAT TO EXPECT

During construction, motorists should expect lane closures between 8:30 p.m. and 6:30 a.m. Electronic message boards and other signage will be used to direct traffic.

Uneven pavement is a common, unavoidable roadway condition with resurfacing projects as the contractor must put down different layers of asphalt during different phases of construction. Motorists are asked to use extra caution while driving through the work zone. Road conditions during construction are short term and will become less apparent as the project progress.
