PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will enhance pedestrian and bicycle safety along Orange Blossom Trail (U.S. 17-92/U.S. 441) between Holden Avenue and 34th Street in Holden Heights. This includes installing three new mid-block crossings with Pedestrian Hybrid Beacons (PHBs.) All new and existing mid-block crossings will have crosswalks that are 3 inches tall by 10 feet wide. These mid-block crossings will also have in-road lighting, fencing, and landscaping in the median. Additionally, the speed limit will be reduced to 30 mph, speed feedback signs will be added, and pedestrian lighting will be upgraded.

WHAT TO EXPECT

During construction, motorists should expect nighttime lane closures and detours on weekdays and weekends. Electronic message boards and other signage will be used to direct traffic through the work zone. Motorists are asked to exercise caution and reduce their speed while driving through the work zone.

The contractor will maintain pedestrian access to sidewalks during construction using signed detours, traffic control devices, and/or temporary walkways and ramps, when appropriate. The construction schedule may change due to weather or other unexpected conditions.
