


S.R. 50 Resurfacing from S.R. 471 to the Lake County Line

Project Description

The purpose of this Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) project is to create a better travel surface and extend the life of the existing roadway by repaving nearly 6.5 miles of State Road (S.R.) 50 from S.R. 471 to the Lake County line in unincorporated Sumter County. The project will repave all travel lanes and the paved shoulders, upgrade drainage as needed, and improve signage and pavement markings throughout the corridor.

S.R. 50, within the project limits, is a two-lane roadway with passing zones. A portion of the project runs through the Withlacoochee State Forest.
