

ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS

S.R. 50 from east of S.R. 471 to Lake County Line

Sumter County

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will provide access management and safety improvements on State Road (S.R.) 50 from east of S.R. 471 to the Lake County line to extend the life of the existing roadway.

Work will consist of milling and resurfacing the roadway from east of S.R. 471 to the Lake County line. The project will cover approximately 6.4 miles and will include drainage improvements, signage, pavement markings and other incidental construction.

WHAT TO EXPECT

During construction, motorists should expect lane closures and detours on weekdays. Electronic message boards and other signage will be used to direct traffic through the work zone.

Uneven pavement is a common condition with projects that require temporary asphalt pavement or resurfacing, as the contractor must put down different layers of asphalt during various phases of construction. Motorists are asked to exercise caution and reduce their speed while driving through the work zone. The construction schedule may change due to weather or other unexpected conditions.

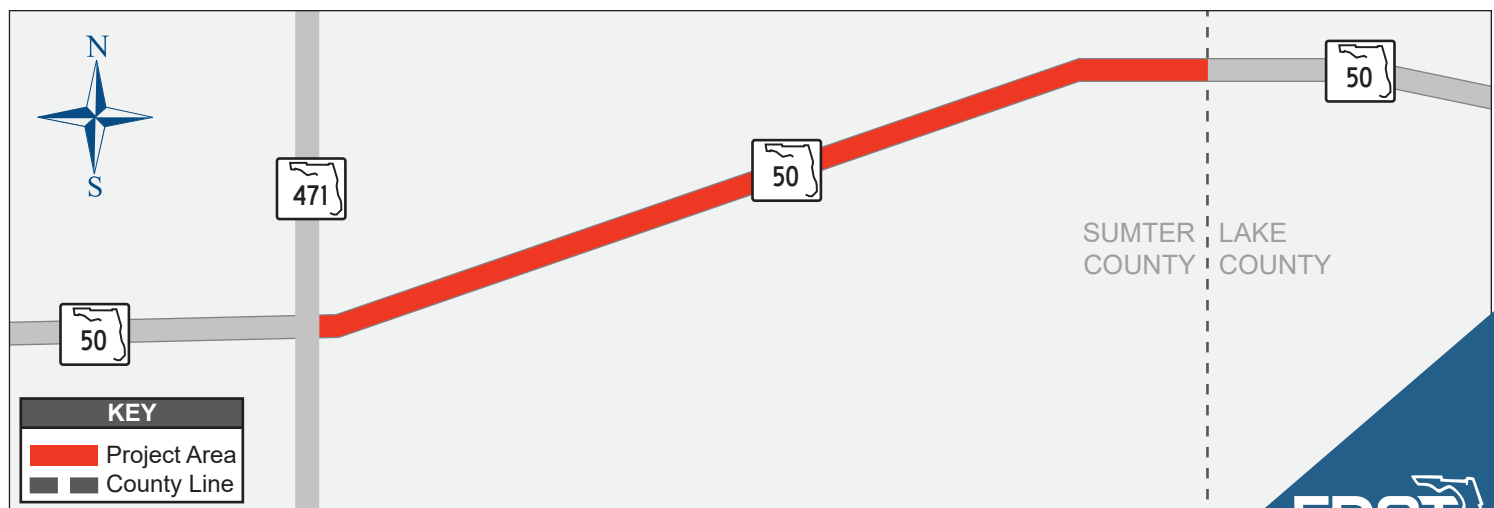
