

ROADWAY RESURFACING

S.R. 44 (E. New York Ave) from Hill Avenue to the I-4 Eastbound On-Ramp

Volusia County

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will be repaving State Road (S.R.) 44, also known as East New York Avenue, from Hill Avenue to the eastbound Interstate 4 (I-4) on-ramp, with the exception of the Kepler Road intersection. A roundabout at S.R. 44 and Kepler Road is planned for a future project, which is scheduled to start construction in Summer 2024.

Additional improvements include minor widening, slope corrections, and guardrail upgrades at the I-4 overpass. This project will also enhance intersection lighting, upgrade pedestrian signals, and reconstruct sidewalk curb ramps to meet current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Motorists can expect nighttime lane closures and traffic shifts on S.R. 44 throughout the project. Workers known as flaggers will use signage to guide drivers around these lane closures and direct them to slow down or stop as needed.

Occasional nighttime off-ramp closures at the I-4 interchange with S.R. 44 (Exit 118A/Exit 118B) between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. will also be required to facilitate construction. During these ramp closures, a detour will be in place that still allows motorists to exit at the interchange. Signage and traffic control devices will direct drivers around all closures.

The contractor will maintain access to sidewalks, businesses, and residences during construction. Pedestrian detours will be utilized as necessary. Motorists and pedestrians are asked to exercise caution while traveling through the work zone.

Uneven pavement is a common, unavoidable roadway condition with resurfacing projects as the contractor must place different layers of asphalt during various phases of construction. Road conditions during construction are short-term and will become less apparent as the project nears completion.

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
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
