### **S.R. 472 Safety Improvements, Volusia County**

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will hold a public meeting regarding project plans on State Road (S.R.) 472 from west of Minnesota Avenue to east of Minnesota Avenue in DeLand on Tuesday, September 14, at 5:30 p.m. The purpose of this project is to construct a new directional median at the intersection of S.R. 472 and Minnesota Avenue to improve safety. The project will also construct a new U-turn that can accommodate large trucks west of the intersection. FDOT is offering multiple ways to participate in the same live meeting.
