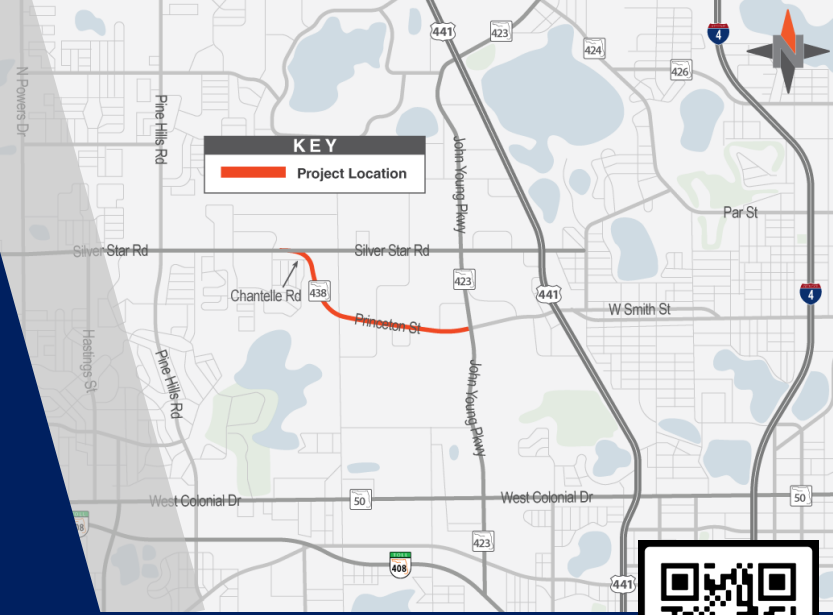




**Princeton Street (S.R. 438)  
Roadway Improvements**  
from north of Chantelle Road to John Young Parkway

**Project Description**

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is planning safety and operational improvements along Princeton Street (State Road (S.R.) 438). The project will repave Princeton Street from north of Chantelle Road to John Young Parkway (S.R. 423) to extend the life of the existing roadway.

Safety and operational improvements include upgrading the traffic signals and adding 7-foot-wide buffered bicycle lanes in each direction. Pedestrian safety will be enhanced by upgrading crosswalks and reconstructing some sections of sidewalk and sidewalk curb ramps to comply with current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards. Drainage adjustments to accommodate the improvements are included.
