




U.S. 1 Improvements from East Ridgewood Avenue to north of Palm Coast Parkway

Flagler County

Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is proposing improvements on U.S. 1 from East Ridgewood Avenue to north of Palm Coast Parkway in the cities of Bunnell and Palm Coast. The project will repave the U.S. 1 corridor to extend the life of the roadway.

To enhance safety, the project also plans to modify the median opening at East Plane Street in front of the Heritage Plaza. The existing open median would be converted to a directional median as shown in the illustration below. The new median will restrict left turns from East Plane Street and the shopping center onto U.S. 1. This reduces the opportunity for left-turn and angle crashes, which can result in the most serious injuries.

Other proposed improvements include adding sidewalk at select locations, and adding pedestrian features and lighting at signalized intersections. Bicycle through lanes next to right turn lanes at intersections (known as keyholes) are planned, as well as new inside paved shoulders. The project also proposes to remove and/or relocating some trees within the landscaped median and install a new traffic signal at County Road (C.R.) 13.
