The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will hold a public meeting regarding project plans on Robinson Street (State Road (S.R.) 526) from Hughey Avenue to Mills Avenue (S.R. 15) (FPID No.: 441143-2) and from Mills Avenue to Maguire Boulevard (FPID No.: 447106-2) in Orlando on Wednesday, July 27, 2022, at 5:30 p.m. The purpose of this project is to create a safer and more efficient roadway for drivers, bicyclists, and pedestrians. FDOT is offering multiple ways to participate in the live meeting.
