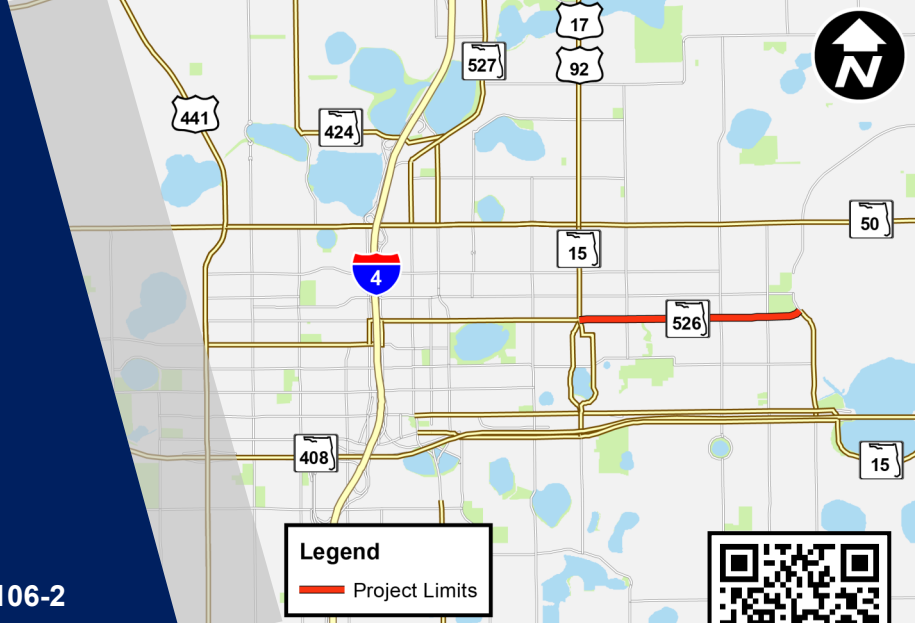




Robinson Street (S.R. 526) Improvements from Mills Avenue to Maguire Boulevard

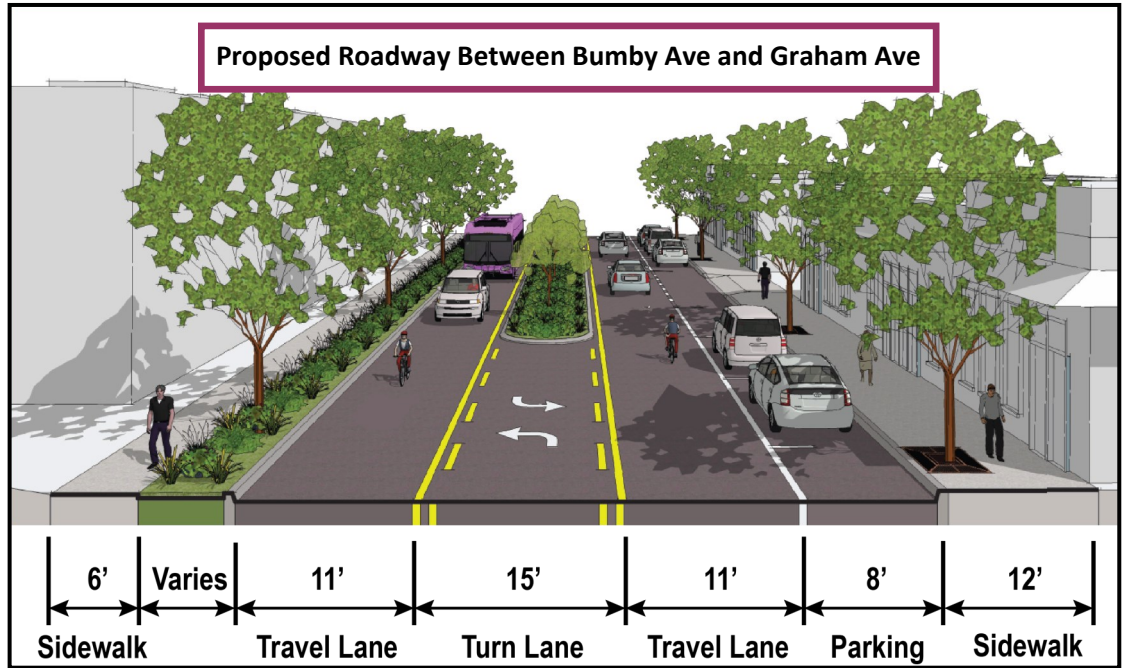


Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) proposes corridor improvements along Robinson Street (State Road (S.R.) 526) from Mills Avenue (S.R. 15) to Maguire Boulevard/North Crystal Lake Drive in Orlando to enhance safety and efficiency.

The project is considering changes to the roadway configuration to encourage slower speeds and improve accommodations for pedestrians. The corridor would have one travel lane in each direction, separated by a center two-way left turn lane between Mills Avenue and Hampton Avenue. Raised medians with openings for left turns will be constructed between Hampton Avenue and Festival Way. The entire corridor will be repaved.

On-street parking areas will be provided on westbound Robinson Street between Altaloma Avenue and Hampton Avenue. There will be some on-street parking on eastbound Robinson Street near Primrose Drive and near Festival Way. Curb extensions are planned to help define the on-street parking areas. Pedestrian safety will be enhanced with improved crosswalks, and reconstructed sidewalk and curb ramps.
