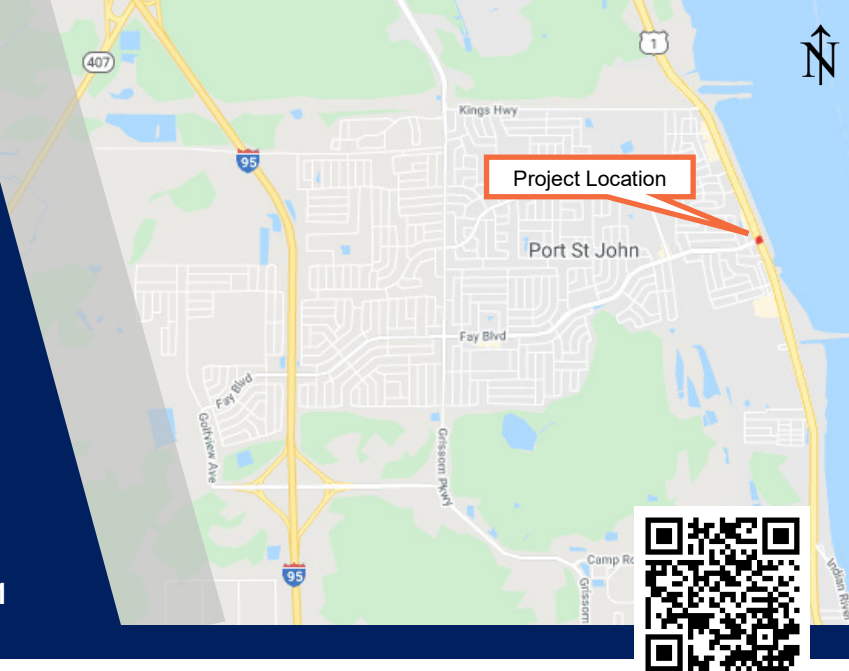




# U.S. 1 Signal Improvements at Fay Boulevard

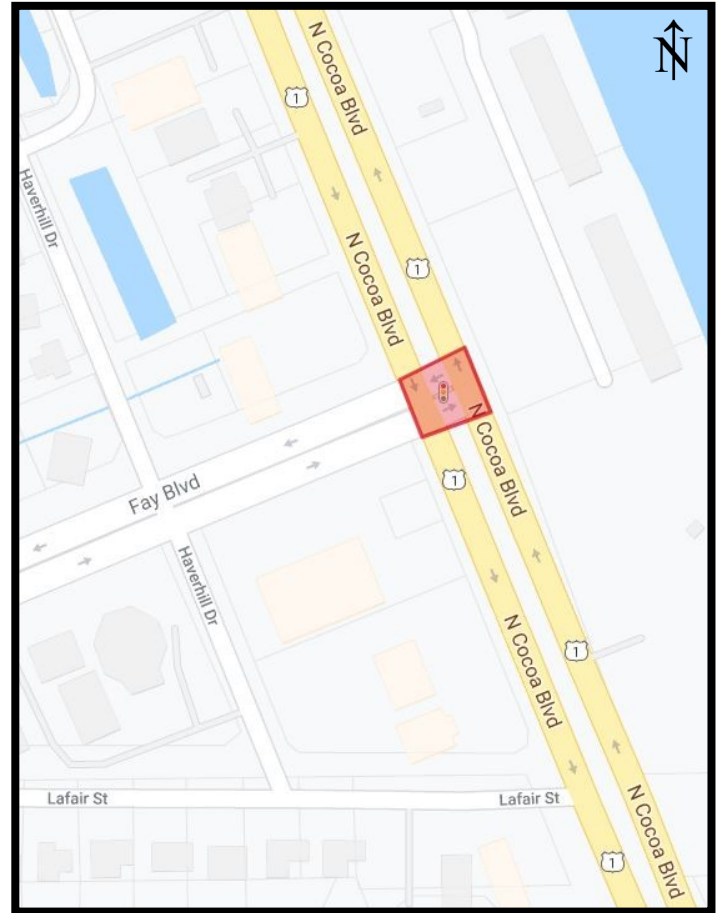


### Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) plans to improve traffic operations and enhance pedestrian safety by reconstructing and upgrading existing traffic signal and signal poles at the intersection of U.S. 1 and Fay Boulevard in Port St. John.

Pedestrian safety improvements include reconstructing the corner curbs and pedestrian curb ramps in accordance with current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards, adding and upgrading crosswalks, and constructing new pedestrian signals.

Some right of way acquisition is expected to accommodate the planned improvements.



### Project Status and Estimated Costs\*

Design:	Ongoing—completion late 2025	\$ 868,000
Right of Way:	Funded—summer 2023	\$ 167,000
Construction:	Funded—early 2026	\$ 600,000
