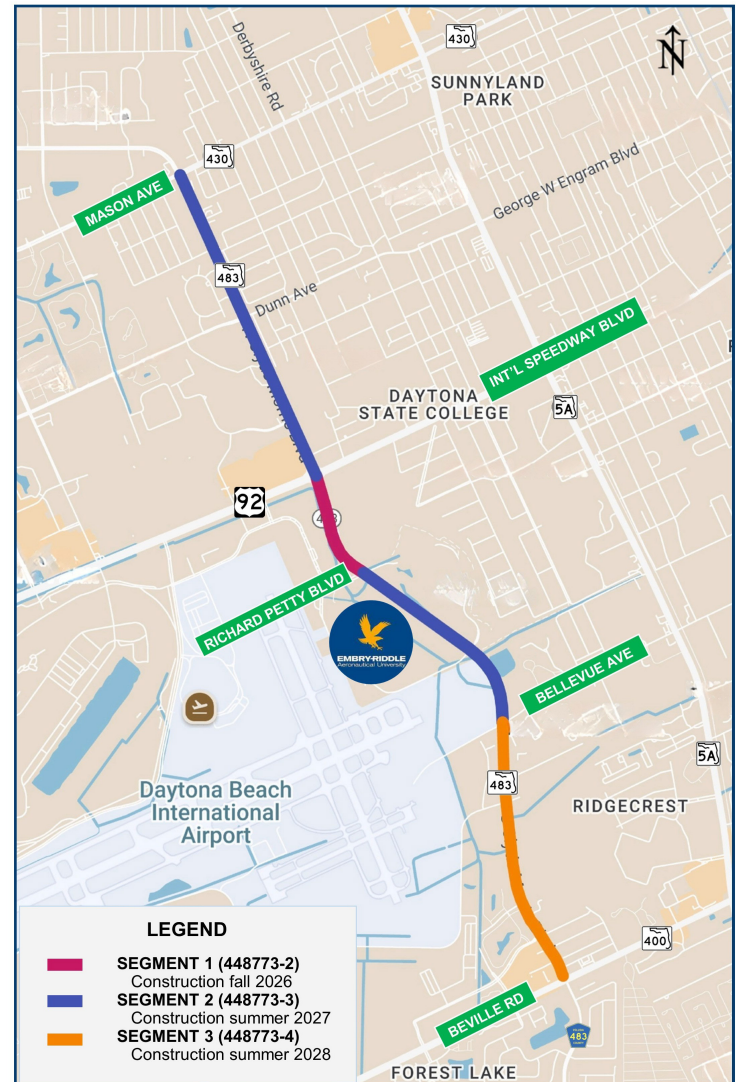


Project Information

The corridor improvements along Clyde Morris Boulevard (State Road (S.R.) 483) from Beville Road (S.R. 400) to Mason Avenue (S.R. 430) in Daytona Beach are designed to enhance safety for drivers, pedestrians and bicyclists, as well as promote efficient traffic operations.

Key features of the work include:

- Resurface the roadway
- Add raised medians to reduce the potential for serious angle crashes
- Build a pedestrian tunnel near the entrance to Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University
- Add a 14-foot-wide multi-use path on the west side of Clyde Morris Boulevard and 8-foot-wide sidewalks on the east side
- Install pipes and fill in the existing open canal near International Speedway Boulevard to create space for the new multi-use path
- Upgrade traffic signals
- Enhance roadway lighting
- Improve drainage
- Install landscaping
