U.S. 301 from south of NE 175th Street to the Alachua County line



PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is resurfacing U.S. 301 from south of Northeast 175th Street to the Alachua County line to extend the life of the existing roadway. The project includes repaying the travel lanes, creating a 7-foot-wide buffered bicycle lane on both sides of the road from the south end of the project to Spring Street (County Road 318), and upgrading the traffic signal at Spring Street.

Additionally, new turn lanes are planned at U-turn locations on the north end of the project. Asphalt will be added at other U-turn locations to provide more space for larger turning vehicles.

WHAT TO EXPECT

During construction, motorists should expect lane closures and detours on weekdays and/or weekends. Electronic message boards and other signage will direct traffic through the work zone. Uneven pavement is a common condition with projects that require temporary asphalt pavement or resurfacing, as the contractor must put down different layers of asphalt during various phases of construction. Motorists are asked to exercise caution and reduce their speed while driving through the work zone. The construction schedule may change due to weather or other unexpected conditions.
