# **BRIDGE IMPROVEMENTS**

North Causeway (Coronado Beach) Bridge carrying S.R. 44 over Indian River

## **Volusia County**


### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is making improvements to the North Causeway (State Road [S.R.] 44) movable bridge over Indian River, also known as the Coronado Beach Bridge, in New Smyrna Beach, Volusia County. This project will replace electrical submarine cables and implement additional minor electrical upgrades that are critical to the bridge's operation. The submarine cables provide electricity to the bridge's machinery, which allows the bridge to open and close for marine traffic to pass through. Replacing the existing cables will ensure continued operation of the bridge for all users.

#### WHAT TO EXPECT

During construction, motorists and pedestrians should expect a period of multiple consecutive days, totaling less than a week, in which the North Causeway Bridge will be closed to roadway traffic. The drawbridge will be raised throughout the roadway closure to allow for removal and replacement of the existing submarine cables. Traffic will be guided to the adjacent South Causeway Bridge and directed by electronic message boards and other signage during the roadway closure. Marine traffic access will be maintained at all times throughout construction.
