

U.S. 1 Resurfacing from Minnie Lane to the Volusia County Line




Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is proposing improvements along U.S. 1 from Minnie Lane to the Volusia County line, north of Mims. The project corridor is designated as part of the Indian River Lagoon National Scenic Byway and is also designated as an evacuation route per the Florida Division of Emergency Management.

In addition to repaying this section of U.S. 1 to extend the life of the roadway, the project proposes to reconstruct turn lanes and paved shoulders to provide bicycle lanes next to right turn lanes (known as keyholes) to enhance bicycle safety.

Pedestrian improvements include new and upgraded crosswalks and pedestrian signals at the U.S. 1 intersection with Anglers Lane/Brockett Road.



Pedestrian curb ramps within the project limits will also be upgraded to meet current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards.

The existing traffic signal at Anglers Lane/Brockett Road will also be upgraded.
