




U.S. 41 (Williams Street) Improvements

from north of the Citrus County line to SW 110th Street

Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is proposing improvements to U.S. 41 (Williams Street) from north of the Citrus County line to SW 110th Street in Dunnellon. The project includes resurfacing the entire corridor to extend the life of the roadway.

The project also plans to reconstruct the intersection at U.S. 41 and Pennsylvania Avenue (County Road (C.R.) 484) to eliminating the island and free-flow right turn lane as shown in the graphic to the right. A designated right turn lane would be added to bring all turning movements under signal control for safety. Additionally, the project will reconstruct the driveway to the plaza on the northeast corner of Williams Street and Pennsylvania Avenue to maintain access.



Traffic signal upgrades are also proposed at the Pennsylvania Avenue, Powell Road, Brooks Street and SW 110th Street intersections. Pedestrian crosswalks and curb ramps will also be improved to meet current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards.
